Third International Workshop on Emission Inventory in Asia

(February 24-25, 2012; Yokohama, Japan)

1. Background and Aim

The development and improvement of emission inventories in Asia is an extremely important task for understanding of atmospheric environmental changes and solution to air pollution on Asian regional and global scales. The research activities for regional/country level emission inventories by Asian researchers are rapidly increasing. However, the collaborative research activities, such as research collaboration, exchange of information and harmonization of each inventory, are very insufficient so far. Given that, these activities need to be strengthened in the research communities related to the emission inventories for Asian regions. Furthermore, establishment of the intensive and interactive linkages among the research groups of forward/inversed modeling and GHG inventories is important.

Based on the above-mentioned background, the "Third International Workshop on Emission Inventory in Asia" aims at (i) understanding the current status of emission inventories in Asia, (ii) exchanging the experience of national/regional emission inventories in Asia, (iii) seeking an effective way to improve emission inventories, and (IV) discussing the future collaboration related to the Asian emission inventory activity.

This is the "revenge workshop" of the second workshop which was suspended by the giant earthquake on March 11, 2011, in Tsukuba, Japan.
