Background and Objectives

Meteorological Society of Japan (MSJ), Chinese Meteorological Society (CMS), and Korean Meteorological Society (KMS) have agreed to strengthen the mutual cooperation and friendship in the field of Atmospheric Science on the basis of equal benefits, organize regional activities in the field of meteorology, and widely inform the activities of the meteorological societies of Japan, China, and Korea to the world community. Based on this agreement, three international conferences have been held in the past:

- (1) First China-Korea-Japan Joint Conference on Meteorology
13-14 May 2005, Tokyo, Japan
- (2) Second Korea-Japan-China Joint Conference on Meteorology
11-13 October 2006, KINTEX, Goyang, Korea

(3) Third China-Korea-Japan Joint Conference on Meteorology
13-16 November 2007, Beijing, China

After the consultation on the successful cooperation, the three parties have reached an agreement to continue the second round of the joint conferences once in every two years.

Postponement due to the novel influenza

Since this spring, the novel influenza A(H1N1) (swine flu) has been propagating widely across the world, and spreading quickly within Japan since 16 May 2009. Meteorological Society of Japan has prepared the emergence of the possible risk of the flu during the J-C-K Joint Conference, and watched carefully for the situation. In order to secure the health of the participants, we have discussed with the Chinese Meteorological Society and Korean Meteorological Society, and agreed that it is difficult to hold the conference as we initially planned, and we decided to postpone the Japan-China-Korea Joint conference with a great regret.

The new dates of the Joint Conference are now set in 8 - 10 November 2009.

If you have already registered in advance prior to the initial dates of the symposium in May, your registration will be automatically applied for the new dates on 8-10 November 2009. If you cannot attend the conference in November and would like to cancel the registration, we will refund your fees so please send an E-mail to LOC secretariat as soon as possible. **We accept the refund of the fees due to the postponement until 31 July (24 JST).**

We also welcome new registration and submissions of papers. If you have already submitted your abstract, it will automatically appear in the abstract collection. **However, in order to confirm your participation, we would like to ask you to submit your (revised) abstract again.** **The deadline of the registration and abstract submission is 31 July 2009 (24 JST).** To submit your abstract, please use the on-line abstract submission page (<http://www.soc.nii.ac.jp/msj/jckjc09/Abstract.html>).

Call for Papers

We welcome new submissions and revision of papers.

Abstract submission

Participants wishing to present their oral or poster presentation are requested to submit a title and a short abstract. **The deadline of the abstract submission is 31 July 2009 (24 JST)**. The abstract should contain the title of paper, author(s), affiliation(s), postal address, E-mail address of the corresponding author, main text, and keywords (within 5 words). The paper must not exceed 1 page in standard A4 size, and maximum file size is 2MB. Figures and tables can be included. The abstract must be in MS-Word, OpenDocument or PDF format, and submitted through the conference website <http://wwwsoc.nii.ac.jp/msj/jckjc09/> after registration. The abstract file should be named as the name of the corresponding author and the first preferred- session number (e.g., Author_S01.doc). Detailed instructions are available in [sample abstracts](#), which are available on the conference website.

The abstract submission should be made only by the corresponding author. At most two presentations are allowed per person. The presentations may be limited to one depending on the total number of the submission.

Guidelines for presentation

Scientific sessions take place at five oral session rooms and one poster session room.

Oral presentation

Time allocation

The time allocated for each presentation is 15 minutes (12 minutes presentation, 3 minutes for Q&A), except keynote presentations.

Equipments

Oral presentations should be presented by PC only. The session rooms are provided with a Microsoft Windows computer with a projector. Acceptable formats for presentations are Microsoft PowerPoint and PDF. The presenters are requested to bring their presentation data file on a USB memory stick, or bring their own portable computers. Please make sure that virus check is executed beforehand.

Poster presentation

Poster boards

Size: Width 90 cm x Height 210 cm

Posters should be displayed on the boards using push pins that will be available at the poster session room. The presenters are responsible for setting up and removing their posters.

Poster display and core time

All posters will be displayed at the poster session room. Posters should be set up between 8:00 and 12:00 on 9 November, and remain up to 16:30. Presenters must show up in front of their posters at least for one hour during the core time of 12:00 to 14:00 on 9 November.

Registration

All participants wishing to present their oral or poster presentation or participants who require documents for visa application from LOC are requested to register on-line using the conference website <http://wwwsoc.nii.ac.jp/msj/jckjc09/>. **The deadline of the on-line registration is 31 July 2009 (24 JST).** On-site registration is available for non-presenter who is a citizen of Japan or visa waiver country only. We solicit your participation to this conference.

Autumn is a beautiful time with colored leaves in Tsukuba Science City. Daytime average temperature in early November is usually around 12 degrees C.

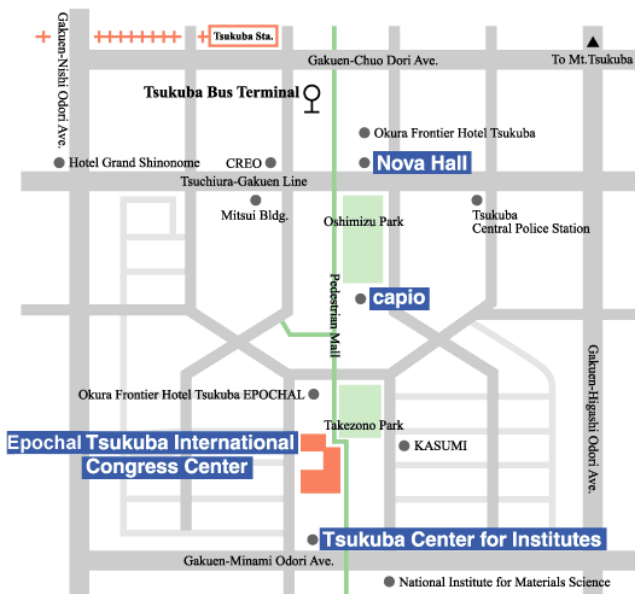
Transportation
